Pray that he would love you the way Christ loves the church.

Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her,
Ephesians 5:25

Pray that he would have strength when tempted.

No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, so that you will be able to endure it.
1 Corinthians 10:13

Pray that God would surround him with godly wise men.

He who walks with wise men will be wise,
But the companion of fools will suffer harm.

Pray for his spiritual growth.

Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth.

2 Timothy 2:15

Pray for him to be more than satisfied sexually.

Let your fountain be blessed,
And rejoice in the wife of your youth.
As a loving hind and a graceful doe,
Let her breasts satisfy you at all times;
Be exhilarated always with her love.

Pray for your marriage to thrive.
