





ATONEMENT. This is such a big word with big meaning. To atone means to make amends or to take someone's punishment. In the Bible, atonement means that Jesus took our punishment when He died on the cross for our sins. We now can have a right relationship with God. In the Old Testament, the Israelites had a 'Day of Atonement'. Look in Leviticus 16:29-30, 23:27-28. Talk about how Jesus was the perfect sacrifice to pay for our sins.




