

# DAY 1

## Jesus' Circumcision Luke 2:21-38

How to use this Study:

This is a time to focus on the Redemption story of Jesus Christ. It's one thing to know events in history, but it is another thing to actually know what those events have to do with Redemption and what they have to do with us. We have chosen 30 events in the life of Christ from His circumcision to His ascension with the hopes of showing you and your children why He came and what should be our response to our great God. During this wonderful Resurrection season, teach your children that Jesus died, was buried, and rose again on the third day. But also teach them WHY and what it has to do with them. I pray this study will help you to do just that.

Each day there will be an ornament to hang up. The printable ornaments are available on my website: [www.nulifecreations.com](http://www.nulifecreations.com). There will be an event and scripture passage to discuss using the children's workbooks. The answers will be here in the parent's guide.

Again, our focus is not just to retell the story of Jesus and His resurrection, but to tell WHY He died and rose again and what impact that should have on us.

Family Activity: Plant Forget-Me-Not flowers. Plant the seeds and talk about why we should never forget the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Don't forget to water your seeds and watch them grow!

## Flight to Egypt & Slaughter of Innocents Matthew 2:13-18



After one days journey, Mary and Joseph realized Jesus was missing and returned to Jerusalem to look for Him. They found Him after 3 days of looking in the Temple with the teachers . The teachers were astonished at His understanding and answers . Jesus told His parents that he had to be in His Father's house. Jesus returned to Nazareth and continued in subjection to His parents.

subjection: to bring under domination, control, or influence.

Point to remember: Jesus put Himself under the authority of His parents. He obeyed them perfectly even though He is God.

Points to bring out: John the Baptist could not save anyone. He could only baptize them with water, which was only symbolic of the person's confession of repentance and new relationship with Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ is the only one that can actually change a sinner's heart and save their soul.

### Optional Experiment: The Holy Spirit's Illumination

One role of the Holy Spirit is to illuminate the Word of God for the believer. That is, the Holy Spirit allows us to read, understand, and apply God's truth's to our lives. To demonstrate this truth, here is an experiment with 'disappearing ink'.

You will need:

Paper

q-tip or paint brush

freshly squeezed lemon juice

heat source such as a lamp or hair dryer

Steps: 1. Write part of the verse with the q-tip dipped in lemon juice.

2. Allow time for it to dry. 3. After it is dry, the words will have disappeared. 4. When the words have been brought under a heat source, such as a small lamp, you will be able to see them.

Teaching point: We cannot understand God's word on our own. We need the Holy Spirit, which God gives freely to all who are Christians!







# DAY 20

**Celebrate the Passover by making unleavened bread as a family. Here is a recipe to try.**

### UNLEAVENED BREAD

1/2 c. water

2 Tbsp. sugar

1 tsp. salt

2 Tbsp. oil

1 1/4 c. flour

Knead until smooth. Roll out to quarter inch thick. Bake at 300 degrees for 30 to 40 minutes. Put on cookie sheet.

This only makes a small batch (about a quart size bag), but it can be doubled easily.




